Habitat for Humanity's ReStore sells donated furniture, appliances, building materials and more to provide a sustainable income for Habitat for Humanity of Warrick County.

Every donation to Habitat ReStore is tax deductible and helps the environment by keeping useful materials from our landfill. Since 2002, the Warrick County ReStore location has kept over 1,954,000 pounds (or 977 tons) of usable material out of our landfill and in use.

100% of the money raised by Habitat ReStore goes to support Habitat for Humanity of Warrick County.

Habitat ReStore gladly accepts the following materials:

Appliances

- MUST BE IN GOOD CONDITION
- Must be no older than 10 years old
- We cannot accept items that need repairs, are missing parts, or smell bad

Bathroom

- Toilets must be in good condition with no stains, have ALL working parts and lid
- · Tubs must be free of significant damage
- · Showers must be in near-new condition
- Vanities must be free of water damage

Cabinets

- Must be in usable, serviceable condition
- Must be damage free
- Particle board/pressed wood cabinets must be in near-perfect condition
- · Must have no water damage
- · All doors and drawers must be included
- · Cabinets that are falling apart are unacceptable

Plumbing

- · Faucets and Fixtures
- PVC, copper, and galvanized pipe and fittings

Doors

- · Must be free of bowing and twisting
- Must be free of holes and deep gouges
- · Must be free of water damage
- · All veneer must be securely attached

Electronics

- · Radios, Stereos, DVD players, Speakers
- Must be in complete working order absolutely no repairs needed

Televisions

- · Cable-ready
- · 5 years old or newer
- · No console TVs
- No projection TVs over 40"

Hardware

- · Door knob sets standard and keyed
- Cabinet Pulls
- Nuts, bolts, nails and screws of all types

Windows

 Must be in good condition – no fogging or cracks, no sashes

Habitat ReStore gladly accepts the following materials. (cont.)

Tools

 Must be in complete working condition – no repairs needed

Gas Grills

 Must be in good working condition – no repairs needed

Flooring

- Carpet must be clean (no stains, spots, holes, or odors)
- Ceramic tile must be intact (no broken pieces) and be in usable quantities (100 sq feet or more)
- Vinyl must be in usable quantities (100 sq feet or more)
- Wood flooring must be in usable quantities (100 sq feet or more), no nails

Furniture

- Furniture must be in good condition!
- Unfortunately, furniture with rips, tears, stains, and significant odors cannot be accepted
- Broken furniture cannot be accepted

Lighting Fixtures

- Must be in working condition ready to use
- No Broken glass
- Ceiling fans must be in complete working order with all pieces intact INCLUDING THE MOUNTING HARDWARE and fan blades

Lumber

- Must be completely de-nailed
- Must be free of rot and water damage
- Must be free of excessive twisting and bowing
- Must be stacked and easily accessible
- Must be 4 feet or longer

Roofing

- Shingles must be in usable quantities/minimum one bundle
- Gutters Galvanized, Aluminum and Vinyl

Counter Tops (without cabinets)

- Must be straight sections 6 feet or longer without sink holes
- Must have no water damage

ReStore's goal is to provide a safe, comfortable shopping experience so that we can sell all of the materials generously donated. For the safety and effectiveness of our volunteers, staff, and customers there are some items that we must turn down.

Unfortunately we are currently unable to accept:

- > Unframed Glass or Unframed Mirrors
- > Cans of Paint less than half full
- > Window Treatments
- > Used Shower Doors
- > Water Bed Mattresses and Frames
- > Mattresses or Box Springs
- > Window Sashes without the Window Frame
- > Sliding Glass Patio Doors without the Door Frame
- > Used Ceiling Tiles
- > No TV's other than Flat Screens- no more than 5 years old

- > Hot Tubs (exterior, multi-person tub)
- > Pool Tables
- > Pianos and Organs
- > Glass Top Tables over 5' long
- > Baby Cribs and Accessories
- > Automotive Supplies
- > Chemicals and Combustibles
- > Clothing and Shoes
- > Kerosene Heaters, or Electric Heaters
- > Propane Tanks
- > Wood Burning Stoves
- > Granite Counter Tops without Base
